## Department of Health Services

Dear Parents/Guardians:

**Any student that does not meet the state requirements for immunizations will not be able to attend school after day 5 of the new school year.**

The following immunizations are required for entrance to public, private and parochial schools in Pennsylvania.

### ***STUDENTS ENROLLING IN KINDERGARTEN NEED:***

- 4 doses of Tetanus Vaccine (1 dose on or after the 4th Birthday)
- 4 doses of Diphtheria Vaccine (1 dose on or after the 4th Birthday)
- 4 doses of Polio Vaccine (1 dose on or after the 4th Birthday)
- 3 doses of Hepatitis B Vaccine
- 2 doses of Varicella (chicken pox) Vaccine or history of disease
- 2 doses of live Measles Vaccine or a blood test showing immunity (vaccine after 12 months of age)
- 2 doses of Live Mumps Vaccine or a signed statement from your physician stating that your child had the disease (vaccine after 12 months of age)
- 1 dose of live Rubella Vaccine (German measles) or a blood test showing immunity (vaccine after 12 months of age)

OR

- 2 doses of MMR (vaccines after 12 months of age)

### ***STUDENTS ENROLLING IN 7TH GRADE NEED:***

- 1 dose of Tdap if five years has elapsed since the last Tetanus Vaccine
- 1 dose of Meningococcal Conjugate Vaccine (MCV) (1<sup>st</sup> dose 11-15 years of age and prior to 7<sup>th</sup> grade)

### ***STUDENTS ENROLLING IN 12TH GRADE NEED:***

- 1 dose of Meningococcal Conjugate Vaccine (MCV) (2<sup>nd</sup> dose at age 16 or older and prior to 12<sup>th</sup> grade)

An immunization record is maintained for your child, and will be kept on file in the health record. Uninsured and underinsured students can visit one of the commonwealth's state health centers or local health departments to get the required vaccines.
