Dear Parents/Guardians:

Flexible Instructional Days will be used by Crawford Central School District for full-day school closures due to inclement weather. By using *Flexible Instructional Days*, the district can maintain student instruction without disruption to the school calendar. The district is able to count the day as a regular day and not have to make it up.

Students should take their laptops home on a daily basis during the winter months. Decisions on the closing of schools will be made either by 5:30 a.m. or 7:30 a.m. if a two-hour delay is called first.

On a *Flexible Instructional Day*, students are expected to log into their classes at their normal starting time each day and participate in any synchronous instruction as scheduled by the classroom teacher. Students are required to complete work and assignments. Teachers will continue to provide instruction during *Flexible Instructional Days* and will be available during synchronous class time and through email. Additional information about class sessions and assignments may be provided by the classroom teacher.

If you need special accommodations or an extenuating circumstance arises, contact your child's teacher(s). Students who are absent will be required to make up missed work as assigned.

We recognize that the decision to provide remote learning may impact families' lives and schedules. For our students and staff, it allows continued daily engagement and instruction without disruption to the school calendar.
