PTO NEWS

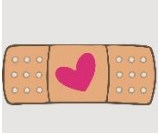
Our next PTO meeting will be Monday, January 7th at 6:30 pm.

NOTES FROM THE NURSE

Happy 2019!! I hope you all had a wonderful and restful holiday!!

Just a few reminders as we get back into the swing of things.....

Cough Drops at School: According to CCSD standing order medication policy cough drops are only administered to students in grades 4-6 with a completed parent consent form (the yellow card completed at the beginning of the school year). Students in Grades K-3 are **not** permitted to have cough drops at school even with a parent note, due to being a choking hazard. If your child is in grade K-3 and you would like them to have cough drops at school a medication order form from a licensed prescriber will need completed. Medication Order forms are available in the Nurse's Office and on the CCSD website under "Departments" -> "Health Services" -> "Medication Administration Form".

Winter Clothes- Please be sure you are sending your child in appropriate winter clothes. Winter coats, hats, gloves, boots and snow pants. If your child is in need of winter clothes please contact Ms. Lisa Hutz, RN or myself in the Nurse's Office at 814-724-4140, we do have some extra winter clothing items and will try to find needed items for your child.

Extra clothes- It's the season of muddy and/or wet clothing from outdoor recess please send an extra pair of clothes with your child in the event they need to

change. Extra clothes for the younger students are also a necessity as accidents do happen and they are more comfortable in their own clothes than the limited nurse's office clothing supply.

Chapstick/Lip Balm- This time of year we see alot of chapped lips in the Nurse's Office. Please have your child bring their own supply of chapstick/lip balm to keep in their bookbag so they can apply it as needed throughout the school day.
