Application Deadlines

- May 1 Summer & Fall
- December 1 Spring

Summer

- Condensed courses
 - 5-7 weeks

Fall & Spring

• 14 weeks, full semester

Cost

- \$100 per credit in state students
- \$150 per credit out-of-state students

- Winter and Summer 1 sessions are not applicable
