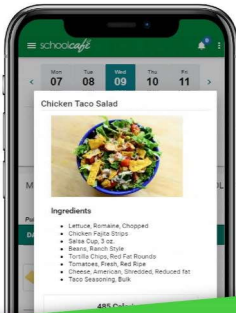
**HAPPY VALENTINE'S DAY!**
