We are happy to announce District-wide participation in the Community Eligibility Program (CEP) after the Pennsylvania Department of Education and the Board of School Directors of Crawford Central School District approved Cochranton Jr.-Sr. High School's inclusion in the program. Although the approval was finalized in October, the program is effective for the first day of the 2022-2023 school year. Administrators are currently working with PrimeroEdge, the food service software provider, to refund monies paid for meals which are covered by CEP. Students will be informed by their office when refunds are complete. Any fund balances may be used towards purchasing a la carte items or second meals.
